OVERVIEW OF POWERPOINT...

- A paid Microsoft Office desktop application
- Microsoft Education store offers discounts to educators, parents and students
- Microsoft offers free one-month trials. Microsoft may also be installed on a new desktop or laptop
- Do not need internet access for PowerPoint although internet access does unlock more features
- Compared to Google Slides, PowerPoint offers more features
- Able to add media to presentations, such as videos, audio, and screen recording

OVERVIEW OF SCREENCASTOMATIC...

- Free, online casting tool
- Allows you to record your screen and add audio
- Records screen, webcam, or both for your presentation, demonstration or lesson
- Can create 15-minute videos for free that can be uploaded to internet platforms such as YouTube and Google Classrooms

OVERVIEW OF YOUTUBE...

- Second most popular search engine in the WORLD (behind Google Search)
- Students do not need a YouTube account to access videos
- Can create playlists specific to your students' needs and can make them public, private or unlisted
- Keep track of your video viewing history
- User friendly

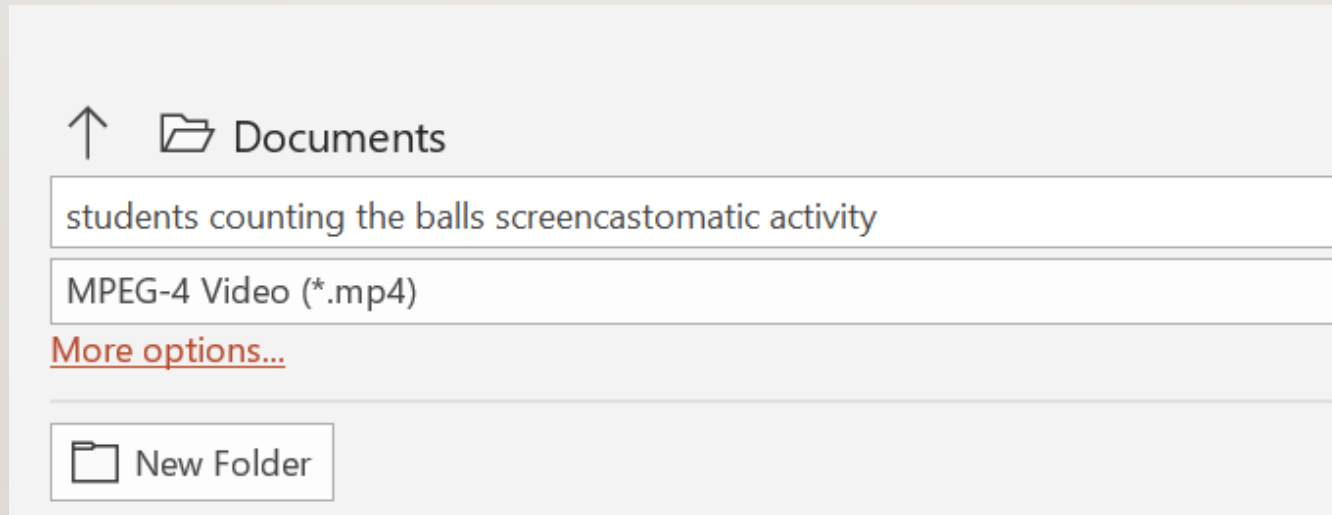

Step 1: Once your content is created, decide if you want to be visible to your students.



Step 2: If you do not want to be visible on screen, you can save as MP4.



Step 3: You can upload to YouTube from your computer with no further steps!

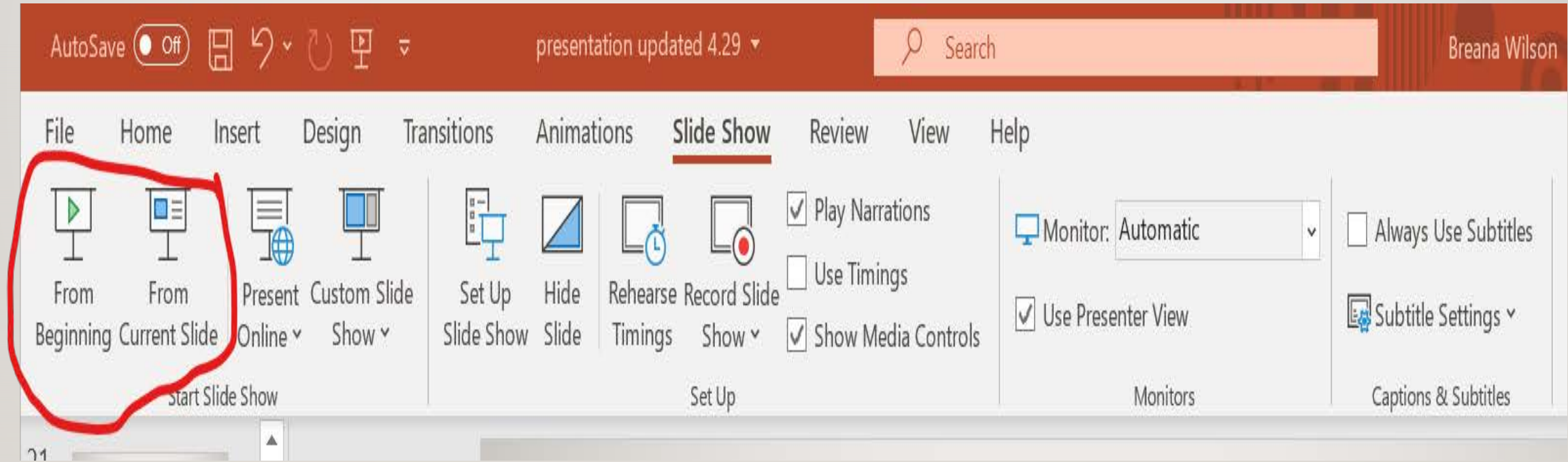

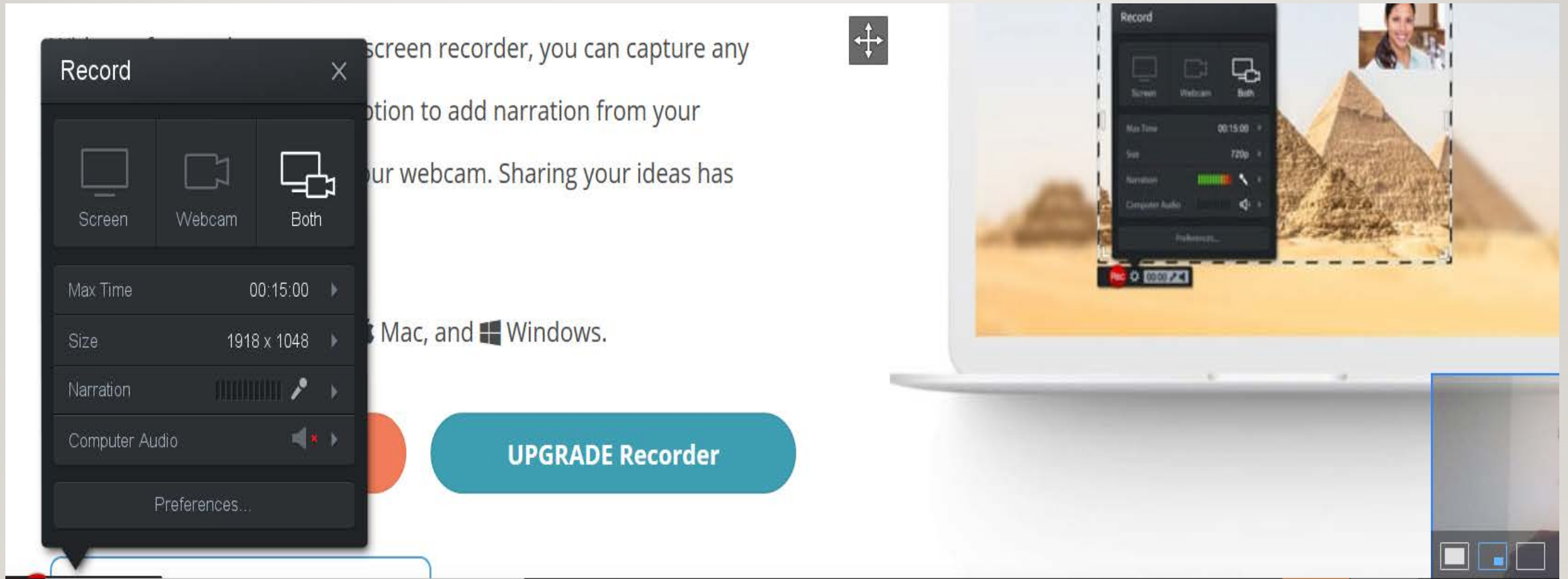

Step 6: Select “Record” and a 3 second countdown will begin. Use this time to begin your PowerPoint.



Step 7: Once you are done recording, you have the option to upload it straight to certain platforms, such as YouTube. If you choose to upload it directly to YouTube, this is what you'll see.

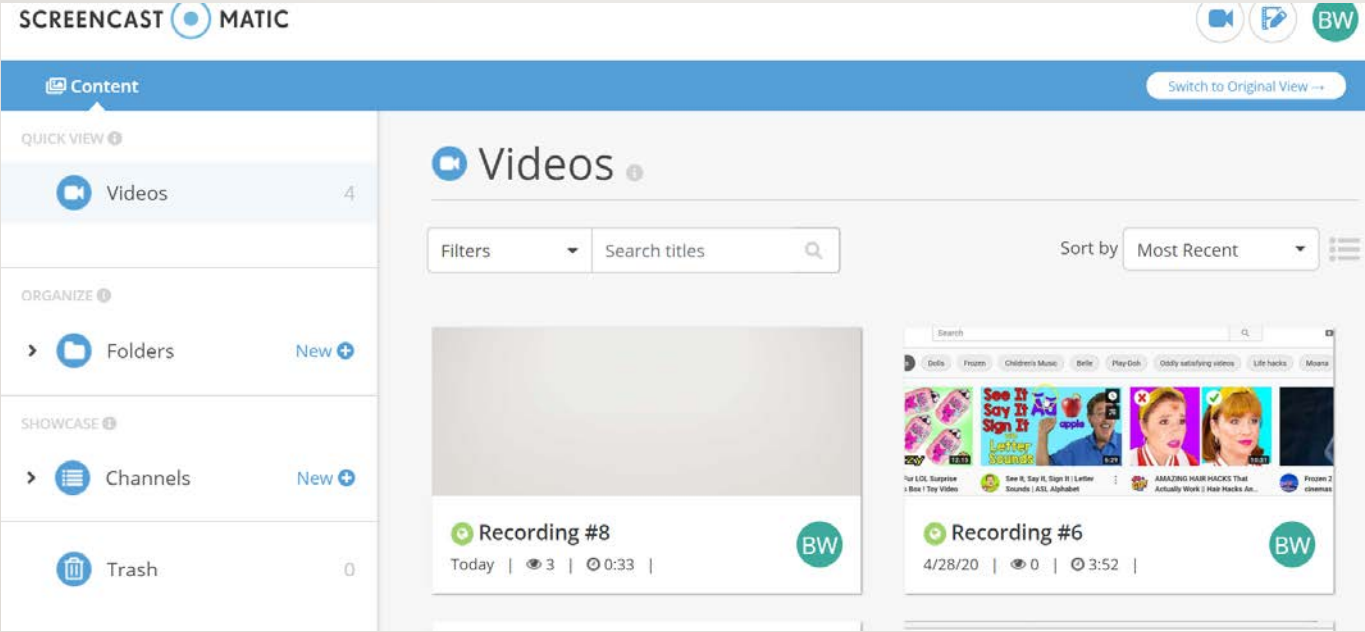

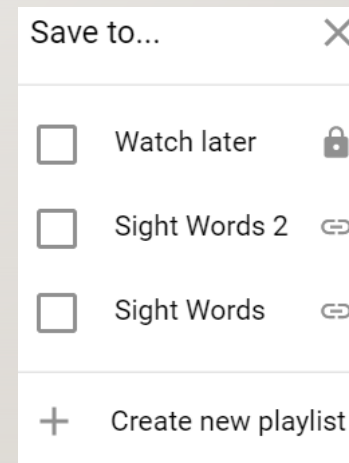
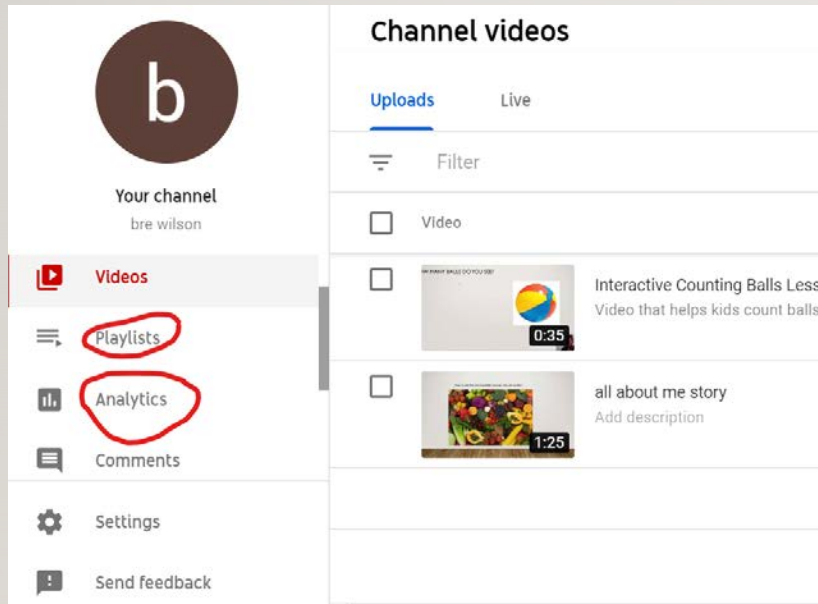
