Video Format and Codec

- File Format:

File Size

- Language: Include subtitles in the primary language and translations (if applicable).

Metadata

 Include: Title, Director's name, Interviewee's names and titles, Runtime, Synopsis, Genre, and Contact information

How Films Are Selected

Find the rubric guidelines below for the selection process.

1. Quality of Storytelling (30 points)

• Engagement (10 points):

- 10: The story captivates the audience from start to finish.
- o 7-9: The story is engaging but has minor lapses in interest.
- o 4-6: The story is somewhat engaging but has several dull moments.
- o 1-3: The story fails to engage the audience.
- o 0: No discernible story.

• Clarity (10 points):

- o 10: The narrative is clear and easy to follow.
- o 7-9: The narrative is mostly clear with minor confusing elements.
- 4-6: The narrative has several unclear or confusing elements.
- 1-3: The narrative is very difficult to follow.
- 0: The narrative is incoherent.

• Creativity (10 points):

- o 10: The story is highly original and imaginative.
- o 7-9: The story is creative but somewhat conventional.
- o 4-6: The story has some creative elements but is mostly conventional.
- 1-3: The story lacks creativity.
- o 0: The story is unoriginal.

2. Craft (25 points)

Technical Quality (10 points):

 10: The video demonstrates exceptional technical quality (e.g., lighting, sound, editing).

- 7-9: The video is technically solid with minor flaws.
- 4-6: The video has several technical issues.
- 1-3: The video has major technical flaws.
- o 0: The video is technically poor.

• Cinematography (5 points):

- o 5: The cinematography is outstanding and enhances the story.
- 4: The cinematography is good and supports the story.
- o 3: The cinematography is adequate but not particularly notable.
- 2: The cinematography is below average.
- 1: The cinematography is poor.
- 0: The cinematography is ineffective.

Editing (5 points):

- o 5: The editing is seamless and greatly enhances the narrative flow.
- o 4: The editing is good with only minor issues.
- o 3: The editing is adequate but has noticeable issues.
- 2: The editing is below average.
- 1: The editing is poor.
- o 0: The editing disrupts the narrative flow.

• Performance (5 points):

- 5: The performances are exceptional and believable.
- 4: The performances are good with minor issues.
- o 3: The performances are adequate but not particularly strong.
- 2: The performances are below average.
- 1: The performances are poor.
- 0: The performances are unconvincing.

3. Innovation (20 points)

• Concept (10 points):

- o 10: The concept is highly innovative and original.
- o 7-9: The concept is innovative with some originality.
- 4-6: The concept has some innovative elements but is largely conventional.
- 1-3: The concept lacks innovation.
- 0: The concept is entirely unoriginal.

• Execution (10 points):

- o 10: The innovative elements are executed flawlessly.
- o 7-9: The innovative elements are executed well with minor flaws.

- 4-6: The innovative elements are executed adequately but with noticeable issues.
- 1-3: The innovative elements are poorly executed.
- 0: The innovative elements are not executed.

4. Impact (15 points)

Emotional Impact (10 points):

- 10: The video has a profound emotional impact.
- o 7-9: The video has a strong emotional impact.
- o 4-6: The video has a moderate emotional impact.
- o 1-3: The video has a minimal emotional impact.
- o 0: The video has no emotional impact.

Memorability (5 points):

- 5: The video is highly memorable and leaves a lasting impression.
- 4: The video is memorable with some lasting impact.
- o 3: The video is somewhat memorable.
- 2: The video is mostly forgettable.
- o 1: The video is entirely forgettable.
- o 0: The video has no memorable qualities.

5. Diversity (10 points)

• Representation (5 points):

- o 5: The video showcases a diverse range of voices and perspectives.
- o 4: The video includes some diversity but is somewhat limited.
- 3: The video has minimal diversity.
- o 2: The video lacks diversity.
- o 1: The video reinforces stereotypes.
- 0: The video excludes diverse perspectives.

Cultural Sensitivity (5 points):

- o 5: The video is highly culturally sensitive and respectful.
- o 4: The video is mostly culturally sensitive with minor issues.
- 3: The video is moderately culturally sensitive but has noticeable issues.
- 2: The video is minimally culturally sensitive.
- 1: The video is culturally insensitive.
- 0: The video is offensive or harmful.

Total: 100 points
