# South Carolina ETV and Public Radio continues legislative coverage with State House Today and launches The State House Gavel

**COLUMBIA, S.C.** – South Carolina ETV and Public Radio (SCETV) remains committed to delivering transparent, comprehensive and accessible coverage of the state's legislative process. As the South Carolina legislative session began on Jan. 14, SCETV continued its tradition of informing and engaging citizens with live and on-demand broadcasts and streaming as well as expanded news efforts.

In collaboration with the South Carolina Legislative Services Agency, SCETV also <u>livestreams</u> legislative sessions and committee meetings, furthering its mission to provide comprehensive political and public policy coverage. Additional programming includes <u>This Week in South Carolina</u>, airing Fridays at 7:30 p.m. on ETV-HD, which provides a recap of the week's top headlines, and the <u>South Carolina Lede</u> podcast, offering in-depth discussions on public policy topics statewide.
